- Record your actions:** Use the questions below to record your actions. Write down the specific action steps you plan to take, along with the names of the individuals or organizations you plan to collaborate with, if applicable.
- Follow up:** Once you have identified your actions, it's important to follow through. Set a timeline for your action steps, and make sure to communicate with your fellow table participants and any partners or collaborators as you move forward.
